

Police to hold beat surgeries in Aldershot

Police in Aldershot are holding beat surgeries in the town to offer residents help and advice.

The events will take place on Saturday, February 6 from 3pm to 6pm in Manor Park and on Saturday, February 13 from 3pm to 6pm in Bridge Road.

PC Natalie Wright and PCSO Matthew McCarthy, of the Manor Park Safer Neighbourhoods team, will be running the events.

PC Wright said: “These beat surgeries are vital to residents in the area.

“It gives them a chance to air their views about community life and how we can work together to solve any problems they may have.

“We will be offering a range of information during the events including important crime prevention advice.”
